Our wardens and teachers are connected with our students and are guiding them to protect themselves from the corona infection. It is our concern to assure basic facilities to our Hostel and School children who come from different grass-root communities. I request all our friends to support our charitable activities that we are doing to glorify the Lord Jesus among these vulnerable children.

COVID 19 – NMSI Emergency Relief (Feed my Sheep): We are distributing food materials and sanitizers during this lockdown period to destitute, widows, differently abled, homeless, transgender, gypsy communities, migrants, farmers, laborers and others who are in deserving state.
